



What steps do you take after you have completed your level 0 seminar.

1. Attend a level 1 - seminar
2. Sit an exam- multiple choice. -After passing.
3. Pay your Registration fee to the ABF
4. Umpire on a regular basis, with accredited umpires who will help and critique your game.
5. Attend a level 1 seminar at least once every two years to keep your accreditation current.

That is all that is required to achieve the level 1 umpire accreditation. We would see all new level 1 umpires wearing the green shirt for at least the first season to keep in with the training and requirements of BQI. Once the State Director feels you are capable then you can change to the blue shirt of an accredited umpire.

What training can you get:

The QBUA meets the second Tuesday of each month at Sporthouse at BQI headquarters at 7.30pm. This meeting is open to anyone who might want to attend and ask questions and learn rulings.

If there is a specific topic you would like covered then you can email your request to the secretary prior to the meeting.

In addition if you have a group of umpires that would like to ask questions that can also be arranged. Either as a Q&A night at your club or alternately after the A grade game on a Sunday where you could come along at your pleasure and view accredited umpires working and then afterwards have a Q&A and also demonstration on field of any questions you may have.

Do you have a question on anything about umpiring:

If you need an answer on a rule or just a general question of something that may have happened in a game?

Do you need to get umpire equipment?

Do you need a rule book or possibly the two umpire hand book?

Do you require help with on field mechanics?

Do you need to contact someone personally?

Do you need to ask a question about the League?

Are you interested in doing State or National Titles?
